

Dropped cupboard doors and draw fronts not closing properly are a common issue within the home but are easy to fix and secure.

To get started you will need...

A Phillips screwdriver

Steps

- 1. Open the cupboard door that is unlevel or dropped.
- 2. Locate the hinge and use the screwdriver to ensure all screws are tight.

- 3. Adjust screw in the middle of the hinge to move the unit door forward or backwards. Be careful not to over tighten the screws.
- 4. Close the cupboard door to see if this has now lined up. If not repeat steps 1, 2 and 3 until this has been rectified.
- 5. If you have a loose draw front, check the screws located behind the handle are tightened.
- 6. Then tighten the screws on the hinges behind the draw front.
